Visual Art Submission Guideline

The Unity Project for Relief of Homelessness in London toasts spring with a grassroots gala of music and art with social conscience, this year at Wilfin Design's downtown loft studios, 428 Richmond Street. Local artists are encouraged to take this opportunity to display their art and help provide emergency shelter, transitional housing and self-help to those struggling to escape and avoid homelessness. *UPwithART* welcomes works from artists at all levels of their development, including beginner, mid-career and senior artists. Your contribution is greatly appreciated!

If you have art you would like to submit, please review the guidelines below:

- Artwork should be in presentation format. We will do our best with our limited means to accommodate those without ability to provide proper framing
- Artwork can only be submitted by the artist who created it HOWEVER we will be happy to have art currently in your home that you would like to donate
- All artwork submitted is subject to approval by selection committee
- Any pieces that do not meet selection criteria will be returned
- The artist has the option of donating entirely or retaining a percentage of the proceeds from the sale of artwork
- A minimum bid is the artist's suggested price at which to start the bidding
- The artist has the option of setting a reserve price, i.e. a price below which the UP may not sell the work, where otherwise the UP may use its discretion in lowering the price if artwork is not selling and the bid closing time nears

The following information is required:

- Artist's name
- Title of submitted piece
- Description of medium used in the work
- Size and Presentation suggestions and any helpful information for mounting
- Minimum bid suggestion, and reserve price, if any.
- Artist's bio, maximum 100 words (include previous experience)
- Artist's contact information including phone number and email
- Artist picture (optional) for small bio displayed with work if selected for show

Please Note:

- Unsold artworks will be returned to the artist upon arrangement
- Personal information collected is for the purpose of accurately representing artists and will be used only in connection with the UPwithART show

We hope you will enjoy the benefit of exposure through UPwithART. Please encourage artists you know to participate. Working together we can put on an inspired art show for the relief of homelessness in London.
